Required for the SMA®

- Administration
- Building Design and Maintenance
- Environmental Health and Safety Issues ●▲

SMA® graduates who would like to get their RPA® or FMA® designation are eligible to receive credit for three courses: The Design, Operation, and Maintenance of Building Systems, Part I and Part II, and Environmental Health and Safety Issues. RPA® and/or FMA® graduates who would like to get their SMA® designation are eligible to receive credit for two courses: Building Design and Maintenance, and Environmental Health and Safety Issues.
